You want to prove yourself competent both as a teacher of young children and as a Christian Early Educator. The credential provides you an opportunity to complete an entry level competency program that has been equated with the nationally recognized CDA. Many states are now legislatively initiating requirements for individuals working with young children to have such a credential.

When you have completed the classes you will receive a completion certificate to send along with your application and \$180 to Liberty. In return you will receive a transcript indicating 12 college credit hours. You are on your way to earning an Associates Degree or finishing a Bachelors!
